FY2019 Small Scrap Tire Sites

Ten (10) small scrap tire sites were remediated in FY2019 at a cost of \$1,027,515.93. Approximately 338,844 Passenger Tire Equivalents (PTE) and 70.76 tons of solid waste were removed from those sites.

FY2020 Small Scrap Tire Sites

Five (5) small scrap tire sites were identified for remediation for fiscal year 2020; two (2) sites have been remediated at a cost of \$9,398.50, which accounted for 683 PTE removed, and three (3) sites are in the process of being remediated through contractual agreements with the Department.

Large Scrap Tire Sites

As of this report, there are no large scrap tire sites awaiting resolution. The Department is currently in litigation concerning the Sullivan site in Macon County to recover cost associated with its clean-up. The site was remediated using STC money and the project was completed in May 2019. A total of 335,785 PTE were removed from the site at a cost of \$888,194.

Discarded Tire Reimbursement Program for Counties

Since the inception of the Department's Scrap Tire Right-of Way (ROW) program in 2011, there has been approximately 1,156,808 PTE removed from county right-of-ways, with a total reimbursement to counties of 7 million dollars. The current ROW agreements are effective from October 1, 2018 (or enrollment date) through September 30, 2021 and offer up to \$150,000 in funding for removal and disposal of scrap tires discarded along county right-of-ways. Currently, 50 of the 67 Alabama counties have enrolled under the new, revised agreement. The Removals and Response Unit is working hard to ensure that all 67 counties are enrolled in the new agreement. New agreement notification letters will be sent out in the spring of 2021.
