### POLLUTION PREVENTION MEANS

- Source reduction and other practices that reduce or eliminate the creation of pollutants through increased efficiency in the use of raw material, energy, water, or other resources; or
- Protection of natural resources by conservation.
- Embracing the waste reduction hierarchy of source reduction, reuse, recycling, and treating. Disposal or other release into the environment is employed as a last resort and should be conducted in an environmentally safe manner. Purchasing products with a recycled content completes the loop.

## SOURCE REDUCTION MEANS

- Reducing the amount of any hazardous substance, pollutant, or contaminant entering any waste stream or otherwise released into the environment (including fugitive emissions);
- Reducing the hazards to public health and the environment associated with the release of such substances, pollutants, or contaminants.

### SOURCE REDUCTION ACTIVITIES

- Input Material Substitution Substitute a solvent with a water based cleaner.
- Improvements in:
  - ⇒ inventory control First In First Out system, so chemicals don't expire and become a waste
  - employee training Train all employees in waste handling and pollution prevention methods
  - spill control Train so fewer spills, inspect containers for leaks or tears upon delivery, catch spilled material before it reaches the floor and becomes contaminated so it may be reused
  - segregate waste streams use grease trap to separate solids from wastewater prior to discharge to the POTW; separate your recyclable waste from non-recyclable
  - efficient production avoid the need to repackage products; dedicated machinery reduces cleanup, schedule to off-peak energy use and negotiate lower electric rate
  - ⇒ housekeeping a neat and clean work area encourages careful handling and
  - ⇒ maintenance, or
- Product Changes Reformulation or redesign of products
- Process or procedure modifications
- Equipment or technology modifications
- Increased efficiency in use of raw materials, energy, water or other resources
- Protection of natural resources by conservation.

#### SAVINGS

An Alabama manufacturer of wooden furniture implemented a waste reduction plan and is saving \$28,000 annually, reduced VOC's by 12,000lbs/yr, and reduced wastes by 14,400lbs/yr.\*
