Summary of Reasons Supporting the Adoption of the Proposed Amendments to the Alabama Department of Environmental Management's Administrative Code for Division 14 (Hazardous Waste Program).

Revisions to the ADEM Admin. Code r. 335-14 are being proposed to adopt two newly codified and revised federal rules promulgated by EPA. The first of these federal rules, *Modernizing Ignitable Liquids Determinations* (hereinafter "the Ignitable Liquids Rule"), was published on July 7, 2020. This rule updates the criteria for identifying ignitable hazardous waste and modernizes the test methods for making such identifications, many of which currently require the use of mercury thermometers. The second of these federal rules, *Conforming Changes to Canada-Specific Hazardous Waste Import-Export Recovery and Disposal Operations Codes* (hereinafter "the Canada Import-Export Rule"), was published on October 1, 2021. This rule updates rules related to twelve hazardous waste import-export recovery and disposal operations between the United States and Canada, which are necessary to reflect changes to rules related to hazardous waste import-export recovery and disposal operations promulgated by Canada on March 17, 2021. The Department proposes additional modifications to make general clarifications, correct typographical or grammatical errors, and maintain equivalency with federal regulations.
