



Air Permit (Gasoline Transporters)

Description:
 Allows gasoline transporters to load/unload gasoline at any refinery, terminal, bulk plant or Stage 1 gasoline dispensing facility.

Issuing Division: Air **Branch:** Energy

When is a permit required?
 When any gasoline transporter is loading gasoline at a refinery, terminal or bulk plant or unloading gasoline at a Stage 1 facility. Transporters are not required to obtain an Air Permit if they are hauling diesel or jet fuel.

Application procedure:
 Owner of a gasoline transport truck will submit a completed application, a current Method 27 Test and permit fee payment.

Base permit fee:
 New trailer - \$1700 per trailer. Change of ownership - \$665 + \$125 per additional permit as long as trailers are from same company, otherwise it is \$445 per trailer. Air Sticker renewals have no charge.

Additive fees (explain):

Term of permit:
 No expiration date - reissue permit only in case of change of ownership. Air Stickers expire 13 months from the month the Method 27 Test was performed, companies must submit yearly Method 27 Tests in order to obtain a new Air Sticker.
