



Beneficial Use Distributor/Generator Registration

Description: A person, organization, or business who provides or resells by-product material to an applicator or end user for land application.

Or

A person, organization, business, industry, agency or institution whose activities or business results in the generation of a by-product material for land application.

Issuing Division: Land **Branch:** Solid Waste
