



Hazardous Waste/Used Oil Transporter Permit

Description: The Hazardous Waste/Used Oil Transporter Permit authorizes the permittee to transport the approved hazardous wastes by the approved transportation mode as specified in the permit.

Issuing Divison: Land **Branch:** Environmental Services Branch

When is a permit required? A transporter of hazardous wastes or used oil must have received an Alabama Hazardous Waste Transport Permit in compliance with ADEM Administrative Code 335-14-8-.09 to 335-14-8-.13.

Days from complete application to issuance: 30 **(minimum)** 180 **(maximum)**

Notes on approval timeline: Permittees are asked to submit application 90 days in advance.

Local approval required? No.

Application procedure: The applicant submits an application and the appropriate fee. The application form is reviewed for completeness and to ensure that all information required by the regulations is received, including a contingency plan and proof of financial assurance. The Contingency Plan is reviewed to determine if it adequately addresses how the applicant will respond to the “worst case” discharge of hazardous waste or used oil during loading, transport and unloading to assure that such discharge does not present a hazard to human health or the environment. The financial assurance instruments are reviewed for compliance with the regulations. If the application is found to be incomplete and/or requirements for permit issuance have not been met, the reviewer can either recommend denial of the permit application or prepare a Notice of Deficiency (NOD) to the applicant. If an NOD is issued, review of the application is placed on hold until additional information is received from the applicant.
