



Major Source Operating Permit (Title V)

Description: Permit authorizes operation of a major source and contains all air monitoring and recordkeeping requirements for the entire facility. Major sources are required to submit renewal applications 180 days prior to expiration of the existing major source operating permit.

Issuing Divison: Air **Branch:** Chemical or Energy

When is a permit required? A major source is required to submit an application within 12 months of commencing operation.

Notes on approval timeline: Timeline assumes no significant public comments and/or no public hearing is required.

Additional Information: Sources pay annual emission fees. No permit fees apply. These are operating permits. Sources typically already hold Air Permits that authorized construction/operation. EPA also has a 45-day review period. The forms required will vary with the source type. The 103 form is always required. The contact person will vary by industry sector.
