



Medical Waste Transporter Permit

Description: A permit required for the movement of medical waste after leaving the generator’s building to any intermediate transfer points, treatment facilities or final point of disposal. The mode of transport may be air, highway, rail, or water.

Issuing Division: Land **Branch:** Environmental Services Branch

When is a permit required? A person engaged in the off-site transportation of greater than 220 pounds of medical waste per month must obtain a Medical Waste Transporter Permit.

Days from complete application to issuance: 30 **(minimum)** 180 **(maximum)**

Notes on approval timeline: Two copies of the Medical Waste Transporter Application must be submitted to the Department 180 days before operation of a new facility or before the expiration date of the previous permit.

Local approval required? No.

Application procedure: The applicant submits an application form with required attachments and the appropriate fee.

Base permit fee: Initial Issuance is \$3,490, Reissuance is \$2,035.
