# STATE OF ALABAMA PUBLIC DRINKING WATER ANNUAL COMPLIANCE REPORT AND SUMMARY FOR 2024



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# Overview of the National Public Drinking Water Program

The US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) established the Public Water System Supervision (PWSS) Program under the authority of the 1974 Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA). Under the SDWA and its 1986 and 1996 Amendments, EPA sets national limits on contaminant levels in drinking water to ensure that the water is safe for human consumption. The Agency also regulates how often public water systems (PWS) monitor their water for contaminants and report the monitoring results to the states or EPA. Generally, the larger the population served by a water system, the more frequent the monitoring and reporting (M/R) requirements. In addition, EPA requires PWS to monitor for unregulated contaminants to provide data for future regulatory development. Finally, EPA requires PWSs to notify their customers when they have violated these regulations.

The SDWA applies to the 50 states, the District of Columbia, Indian Lands, Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands, American Samoa, Guam, and the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands.

The SDWA allows states, tribes, and territories to seek EPA approval to administer their own PWSS Programs. The authority to run a PWSS Program is called 'primacy'. For a state to receive primacy, EPA must determine that the state meets certain requirements laid out in the SDWA and the federal regulations, including the adoption of drinking water regulations that are at least as stringent as the federal regulations and a demonstration that they can enforce the program requirements. Of the 56 states and territories, all but Wyoming and the District of Columbia have primacy. EPA regional offices administer the PWSS programs within these two jurisdictions.

The 1986 SDWA Amendments gave Indian tribes the right to apply for and receive primacy. EPA currently administers PWSS programs on all Indian lands except the Navajo Nation, which was granted primacy in late 2000.

The 1996 Amendments to the SDWA require consumer notification to include a clear and understandable explanation of the nature of the violation, its potential adverse health effects, steps that the PWS is undertaking to correct the violation and the possibility of alternative water supplies during the violation.

#### **Definitions**

The following terms are used in this report and are defined as noted below.

- Annual Compliance Report: The Annual Compliance Report is an annual report of violations of the primary drinking water standards that the states provide to the EPA. Each quarter, primacy agencies submit data to the Safe Drinking Water Information System (SDWIS/FED), an automated database maintained by EPA. The data submitted include, but are not limited to, PWS inventory information, the incidence of MCL, MRDL, monitoring and reporting, and treatment technique violations, and information on enforcement activity related to these violations. Section 1414(c)(3) of the SDWA requires states to provide EPA with an annual report of violations of the primary drinking water standards. This report provides the numbers of violations in each of six categories: Maximum Contaminant Levels (MCLs), Maximum Residual Disinfectant Levels (MRDLs), treatment techniques, variances and exemptions, significant monitoring violations, and significant consumer notification violations. The EPA regional offices report the information for Wyoming, District of Columbia, and all Indian lands with exception to the Navajo Nation. EPA Regional offices also report federal enforcement actions taken. Data retrieved from SDWIS/FED form the basis of this report.
- Consumer Notification (Consumer Confidence Report CCR): Every community water system is required to deliver to its customers a brief annual water quality report, 'Consumer Confidence Report' (CCR). This report is to include some educational material, and will provide information on the source water, the levels of any detected contaminants, and compliance with drinking water regulations.
- Enforcement Targeting Tool (ETT): The enforcement targeting tool is a calculation method used by EPA to identify and prioritize public water systems deemed to be out of compliance with drinking water rules and regulations. The ETT targets systems requiring formal enforcement action in order to facilitate a return to compliance.
- Maximum Contaminant Level: Under the SDWA, the EPA sets national limits on contaminant levels in drinking water to ensure that the water is safe for human consumption. These limits are known as Maximum Contaminant Levels (MCLs).
- Maximum Residual Disinfectant Level: The EPA sets national limits on residual disinfectant levels in drinking water to reduce the risk of exposure to disinfectant byproducts formed when public water systems add chemical disinfectant for either primary or residual treatment. These limits are known as Maximum Residual Disinfectant Levels (MRDLs).
- Monitoring and Reporting: A PWS is required to monitor and verify that the levels of contaminants present in the water do not exceed the MCL or MRDL. If a PWS fails to have its water tested as required or fails to report test results correctly to the primacy agent, a monitoring and reporting violation occurs.

- **Public Notification Violations:** The Public Notification Rule requires all PWSs to notify their consumers any time a PWS violated a national primary drinking water regulation or has a situation posing a risk to public health. The time period that a PWS has to notify the public depends upon the risk posed by the violation or situation. Notices must be provided to persons served (not just billing consumers).
- Public Water System (PWS): A PWS is defined as a system that provides water via piping or other constructed conveyances for human consumption to at least 15 service connections or serves an average of at least 25 people for at least 60 days each year. PWS can be community water systems "CWS" (such as towns), non-transient non-community water systems "NTNC" (such as schools or factories), or transient non-community water systems "TNC" (such as rest stops or parks). For this report, when the acronym 'PWS' is used, it means systems of all types unless specified in greater detail.
- **Significant Consumer Notification Violations:** For this report, a significant consumer notification violation occurred if a community water system completely failed to provide its customers the required annual water quality report, known as the Consumer Confidence Report (CCR).
- Significant Monitoring and Reporting Violations: For this report, significant monitoring and reporting violations are generally defined as any significant monitoring violation that occurred during the calendar year of the report. A significant monitoring and reporting violation, with rare exceptions, occurs when no samples were taken or no results were reported during a compliance period.
- **Significant Public Notification Violations:** For this report, significant public notification violation occurs when a PWS completely fails to notify its consumers that the PWS violated a national primary drinking water regulation or had a situation posing a risk to public health.
- **Treatment Techniques:** For some regulations, the EPA establishes treatment techniques (TTs) in lieu of an MCL to control unacceptable levels of certain contaminants. For example, treatment techniques have been established for viruses, some bacteria, and turbidity.
- Variances and Exemptions: A primacy state can grant a PWS a 'variance' from a primary drinking water regulation if the characteristics of the raw water sources available to the PWS do not allow the system to meet the MCL. To obtain a variance, the system must agree to install the best available technology, treatment techniques, or other means of limiting drinking water contamination that the state finds are available (taking costs into account), and the state must find that the variance will not result in an unreasonable risk to public health. The variance shall be reviewed not less than every 5 years to determine if the system remains eligible for the variance.

A primacy state can grant an 'exemption' temporarily relieving a PWS of its obligation to comply with an MCL or treatment technique or both, if the system's noncompliance results from compelling factors (which may include economic factors) and the system was in operation on the effective date of the MCL or treatment technique requirement. The state must require PWS to comply with the MCL or treatment technique as expeditiously as practicable, but not later than 3 years after the otherwise applicable compliance date.

# Public Water Systems in Alabama

ADEM's Drinking Water Branch regulates public water systems. There are two types of public water systems: community water systems and non-community water systems.

Community water systems serve the same people year-round. Examples of community water systems include water systems owned and operated by cities, towns, counties, and mobile home parks. At the end of 2024, there were 504 community water systems in Alabama.

Non-community water systems are water systems that serve the public but do not serve the same people year-round. There are two types of non-community water systems: non-transient and transient. A non-transient non-community water system serves the same people more than six months per year, but not year-round. Examples of non-transient non-community water systems include schools and industries that have their own water supply system. At the end of 2024, there were 22 non-transient non-community water systems in Alabama. A transient noncommunity water system serves the public, but not the same individuals, at least 60 days per year. Examples of transient non-community water systems include rest areas and campgrounds that have their own water supply system. At the end of 2024, there were 43 transient non-community water systems in Alabama.

This Annual Compliance Report is a snapshot of the status of compliance in the state of Alabama during calendar year 2024. This report provides the number of violations during calendar year 2024 in the following categories.

- Maximum contaminant level (MCL) violations.
- Maximum residual disinfectant level (MRDL) violations.
- Treatment techniques (TT) violations.
- Significant Monitoring and Reporting requirements (M/R) violations.
- Significant monitoring requirement (M) violations.
- Significant reporting requirement (R) violations.
- Variances and exemptions.
- Recordkeeping violations.
- Significant public notification requirement violations.
- Significant consumer confidence report (CCR) notification requirement violations.

# Public Water System Violations and Compliance

#### **Inorganic Contaminants**

Inorganic contaminants (IOCs) are naturally occurring in some ground water and surface water, but can also be introduced to water through farming, chemical manufacturing and other human activities. Inorganic contaminants are routinely monitored in PWSs that utilize ground water every three years, except nitrite/nitrate, which is monitored annually.

One (1) PWS incurred significant monitoring/reporting violations during 2024. One (1) PWS incurred significant monitoring/reporting violations of the Drinking Water Arsenic rule and seven (7) PWSs incurred significant monitoring/reporting violations of the Drinking Water Nitrate rule during 2024. The table below summarizes violations of the contaminants that were required to be monitored.

#### Organic Contaminants

PWSs are required to monitor for two categories of organic contaminants: synthetic organic contaminants (SOCs) and volatile organic contaminants (VOCs). In most cases, these contaminants are monitored every three years, except when required to monitor more frequently due to detections or MCL exceedances.

#### Synthetic Organic Contaminants

Six (6) PWSs incurred significant monitoring/reporting violations during 2024. The table below summarizes violations of the contaminants that were required to be monitored.

#### **Disinfection By-Products**

PWSs are required to kill or inactivate pathogenic organisms in water by use of chemical oxidants or equivalent agents. By-products of disinfection, disinfection by-products (DBPs), occur in water as a result of organic matter reacting with the disinfection chemicals (e.g., chlorine) present in drinking water. PWSs monitor DBPs either annually or quarterly, depending upon source, size of population and/or previous results.

Twenty-eight (28) PWSs incurred significant monitoring/reporting violations and nine (9) PWSs had MCL violations under the Stage 2 DBP Rule. The table below summarizes violations during 2024 for the DBPs required to be monitored by PWSs.

#### Microbiological Contaminants

Total coliforms are a group of related bacteria that are (with few exceptions) not harmful to humans. EPA considers total coliforms a useful indicator of other pathogens for drinking water. Total coliforms are used to determine the adequacy of water treatment and the integrity of the distribution system.

Under the Revised Total Coliform Rule (RTCR), non-acute MCL violations are not issued; rather, systems that have treatment technique triggers are required to do a special assessment of their water systems to identify and correct the problem(s). Water systems that fail to conduct the special assessment for the treatment technique triggers are issued a treatment technique violation. Water systems that fail to conduct the special treatment assessment for the treatment technique triggers or fail to perform corrective actions following the special treatment assessment are issued a treatment technique violation.

The following table summarizes violations of the RTCR during 2024 in three categories: (1) acute MCL violations (presence of fecal coliform or E. coli); (2) major monitoring violations (failure to take any samples on time and failure to take any necessary repeat samples); and (3) treatment technique violations.

Eighteen (18) PWSs incurred significant monitoring/reporting violations and one (1) received an MCL violationduring 2024. The table below summarizes violation types that occurred.

#### Lead and Copper Rule

Lead and copper can be a source contaminant and can enter drinking water through interactions with distribution system and plumbing materials. The table below summarizes the following categories of violations in 2024.

- Initial Lead and Copper Tap M/R: A violation where a system did not meet initial lead and copper testing requirements or failed to report the results of those tests to the State.
- Follow-up or Routine Lead and Copper Tap M/R: A violation where a system did not meet follow-up or routine lead and copper tap testing requirements or failed to report the results of those tests to the State.
- Treatment Installation: Violations for a failure to install optimal corrosion control treatment system or source water treatment system which would reduce lead and copper levels in water at the tap. (One number is to be reported for the sum of violations in both categories).
- Lead Service Line Replacement: A violation for a system's failure to replace lead service lines on the schedule required by the regulation.
- Public Education: A violation where a system did not provide required public education about reducing or avoiding lead intake from water.
- Monitoring: EPA specifies which water testing methods the water systems must use and sets schedules for the frequency of testing. A water system that does not follow EPA's schedule or methodology is in violation [40 CFR 141].

Forty-two (42) PWSs incurred significant monitoring/reporting violations of the lead and copper rule (LCR) during 2024. The table below summarizes violations of the contaminants that were required to be monitored.

#### Lead and Copper Rule Revisions

These inventories contain lists of service lines – the pipes that connect buildings to water mains – indicating the materials the lines are composed of. #### Surface Water Treatment Rule

The Surface Water Treatment Rule establishes criteria under which water systems supplied by surface-water sources, or ground-water sources under the direct influence of surface water, must filter and disinfect their water [40 CFR 141, Subpart H].

One (1) PWS incurred a treatment technique violation during 2024 under the Long Term 2 Enhanced Surface Water Treatment Rule (LT2). The table below summarizes violations during 2024 in two categories: treatment techniques and monitoring/reporting violations.

#### Radionuclide Contaminants

Radioactive particles can naturally occur in ground water and surface water but can also be introduced to water through human activities. EPA has set legal limits on four types of radionuclides: radium-226, radium-228, gross alpha, and beta particle/photon radioactivity [40 CFR 141].

Four (4) PWSs incurred significant monitoring/reporting violations during 2024. The table below summarizes violations of the contaminants that were required to be monitored.

### **Summary**

There were 132 PWSs that had approximately 601 violations in calendar year 2024. One water system may have more than one violation. There were a total of 31 health based MCL violations from 11 PWSs. There were a total of 570 non-health based violations that included monitoring/reporting and treatment technoique violations from 128 PWSs.

The majority of all drinking water violations for calendar year 2024 were non-health based violations which involved failure to submit a sample, failure to report test results, or failure to provide report/documentation to the Department. These administrative violations do not indicate any problems with the quality of the drinking water.
