Summary of Reasons Supporting the Adoption of Proposed Revisions

The Department proposes to adopt revisions to the following rules:

335-6-10-.07 Toxic Pollutant Criteria Applicable to State Waters

335-6-10-.07(1)(d)(1)(iii)

- The Department proposes to remove language regarding the use of values in U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's Integrated Risk Information System (IRIS) as the default in computing numeric water quality criteria to comply with Act No. 2026-81.

335-6-10-.07(1)(d)(2)(iii)

- The Department proposes to remove language regarding the use of values in U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's Integrated Risk Information System (IRIS) as the default in computing numeric water quality criteria to comply with Act No. 2026-81.

335-6-10-.07(1)(g)

- The Department proposes to remove this paragraph due to the removal of corresponding references that were found in 335-6-10-.07(1)(d)(1)(iii) and 335-6-10-.07(1)(d)(2)(iii).

335-6-10-.11 Water Quality Criteria Applicable to Specific Lakes

335-6-10-.11(2)(a)3.

- The Department proposes to administratively correct the punctuation error in the surface area value for Woodruff Lake. The value should have been 12,510 acres instead of 12.510 acres.
